A Needs Assessment of Pastoral Counselors in Honduras: A Delphi Study

This study examines the mental health needs of Hondurans as identified by a sample of 20 pastoral counselors conducted by utilizing the Delphi method (Dalkey, 1969) while enrolled in a family and marriage counseling course. Three key constructs are identified comprising the rationales guiding this investigation: (1) The considerable attention being raised in how indigenous psychology, multicultural counseling competency (MCC), and internationalization of counseling are being examined and valued in North America and abroad; (2) the deficiency of studies focusing on best practices in counseling Hondurans (Sells et al., 2007); and (3) the advantages of anticipated benefits to counselors meeting cultural challenges in North America.

The Latina Value Scale-Revised: A cross-sectional analysis of *marianismo* in Latina women.

Assisted at the BTP clinic in the implementation of a research study sponsored by Francis Melendez and Magdalena M. Sanchez. The study focused on the concept of *marianismo*; defined by women's family, community, and church values. The study looked at the assessment tool "The Latina Value Scale" created to measure *marianismo* and identify areas of conflict, satisfaction/dissatisfaction for the Latino

women. The goal of the study was to revise and translate the Latina Value Scale into Spanish to assess if marianismo is measurable with a Latina population from diverse educational, socioeconomic, and cultural backgrounds who are primarily monolingual. Collected data through verbal and questionnaire interviews of 200 women within the hospital setting.
